

Pillow Case Instructions:

3/4 yd. cotton fabric for pillow case

1/3 yd. cotton fabric for border

1 1/2 " x 26 1/2 " accent stripe

- Cut body of case 26 1/2 " x 40 1/2" and border 10 1/2" x 40 1/2" and accent stripe 1 1/2" x 26 1/2". Iron both border and accent stripe in half, lengthwise, with wrong sides together, and press.
- Place the raw edges (40 1/2" lengthwise) of the folded accent stripe on top of the **right side** 40 1/2" edge of the case body. (See sketch #1) Unfold the border fabric and place the right side of the border (lengthwise) on top of the accent stripe. Sew 1/4" (or serge) seam along lengthwise edge. There will be 4 thicknesses of fabric (1 case body, 2 for the folded accent stripe, 1 case border). (see sketch #2) Press accent stripe flat, with the folded edge towards the raw edge of the border fabric.
- Serge, or zigzag remaining raw edge of border fabric (lengthwise).
- Place right sides of the pillow case together and sew or serge along length, matching accent stripe and 10 1/4" of border (1/4" will be in the seam) as you sew. Sew along the top edge of the main pillow case fabric.
- Fold border fabric (wrong sides together) on previously pressed line. Single serged or zig zagged edge should match up with the underside of the accent stripe. Pin in place on right side of pillow case along accent stripe. Sew (topstitch) close to folded edge of accent stripe, catching the edge of the border fabric underneath to secure.

Make sure to wash the fabric (or leave a note on it that it has not been washed) for the protection of children with suppressed immunity.
